STAR ACTIVITIES AND INTENDED RESULTS

WHY STAR?

In all the participating countries disabled people suffer from a real discrimination in society and concerning their integration into the labor market. The unemployment rate of disabled people is double as high as for other categories of unemployed.

Moreover, the disabled persons often have other kinds of handicaps like a lower qualification. All these facts underline the necessity of this project.

The project partners want to facilitate a positive change of the society in general and also of the employers towards disabled people.

WHAT IS STAR?

STAR is an European project that was born in 2013 with the goal to reduce the discriminatory and disadvantageous situation of the disabled people and to exchange good practices of reintegration.

We are 5 institutions from different countries: Austria, Czech Republic, France, Hungary and Slovakia.

The objective is to enhance the integration of disabled people into the labour market and to improve their personal development and participation in an active citizenship.

We want to conduct a questionnaire-based survey to identify the constraints and requirements of the disabled and employers.

- Analysis of the job situation of the target group in the partner regions.
- A questionnaire-based survey of the primary target group and employers.
- Cooperation with employers and other labour market actors during the survey.
- The project results will be presented in brochures and DVD-Roms (in six languages: English, Slovakian, French, German, Hungarian, Czech) and also be published on the project webpage.
